

# Scaffolding Classroom Management

The Scaffolding Classroom Management workshop will help participants develop systems to increase student engagement and maximize time available for teaching and learning. The model presented will define, teach, and reinforce consistent classroom structures and systems. These systems and structures will help to create classrooms in which students and adults can articulate and model clear expectations. When systems, structures, and interactions are functional, it allows for day-to-day management of the classroom that ensures the teacher has time to focus on academic learning.
