

STUDENT INTERVENTION REPORT

Objective: To use an advanced search tool that runs a list of interventions by district, high school, middle school or elementary schools.

Considerations for Usage

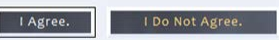
1. To run reports for the entire campus by specific grade levels.
2. To populate a list for the following “Intervention Types” possibilities:
 - a. Academic, Attendance, Behavior, Speech, Oral Language, AIP, ILP, Service Tracking, and Roster Based Programs for any grade level.



1. Click on “AISD CLOUD” icon
2. Log into “AISD CLOUD”



3. Click on “eCST” icon



4. Click on “I Agree”



5. Click on “Reports”



6. Click on “Student Intervention Records.” Once you click on “Student Intervention Records” you will see the “Student Intervention Report” screen with filters.

7. Click on the **drop-down boxes** to select the **Grade Level, Plan Type, and “Record Range” (the start and end date)** of desired report.
 8. Click on **“Search”** button.
- The report will generate based on the selected filters and generate a list of students. You will see all Interventions, ILPs, AIPs, Service Tracking and RBPs for the entire grade level.

- The report will list the total number of interventions by column for each category:
 - **Academic, Behavior, Attendance (Attend), Speech, ILP, AIP, Referrals (Ref), Service Tracking (Svc Track), Meeting Records (Mtg Recs) and Alerts.**
- Each category will have a sub-category that indicates the status of the intervention:
 - **A: Active, D: Draft, C: Completed or Closed or I: Inactive.**

Status Abbreviations

A - Active C - Completed D - Draft I - Inactive
